Box 1

- Total amount of payments received for QTRE from **all sources** during the calendar year.
- The amount reported is the total amount of payments received, less any reimbursements or refunds made during the calendar year that relate to the payments received for QTRE during the same calendar year.
- The amount reported is not reduced by scholarships or grants reported in Box 5.

Box 4

- Adjustment made for a prior year for QTRE that was reported on a prior year Form 1098-T.
- This amount may reduce any allowable education credit that you claimed for the prior year.

Box 5

- Total amount of scholarships and grants for payment of a student's cost of attendance. Scholarships and grants generally include all payments received from third parties (excluding family members and loan proceeds).

Box 6

- Total amount of any adjustments to scholarships or grants that were reported in a prior year.

Box 7

- This box will be checked if any payments received for QTRE reported for 2021 relate to an academic period that begins in January through March 2022.
